Board of Education Meeting Updates

During its meeting on February 2nd, 2016, the Board of Education:

- Learned about the AVID program and its role in Freeport School District.
- Approved the Freeport School District and CareerTec Bills, the Personnel Report with an addendum, and the annual Hazardous Walking Areas list.
- Approved the <u>CollegeNOW Agreement</u> between FSD and Highland Community College for the 2016-2017 Academic Year.
- Approved revisions to the following job descriptions:
 - * Equity Secretary
 - * Asst. Principal for Alternative Education

During its meeting on February 16th, 2016, the Board of Education:

- Recognized the FHS Student Council and learned about their activities.
- Received a monthly update on the finances of the district. This update included:
 - * January 2016 Revenues
 - * January 2016 Expenditures
 - * January 2016 Board Investment Report
 - * Status of State Funding
- Received a mid-year update on the progress of the Department of Curriculum and Instruction.
- Reviewed the <u>second quarter data on the implementation of behavior supports</u> such as Positive Behavior Interventions & Support (PBIS) in FSD schools.
- Reviewed a recommendation to increase social work support in the schools over the next 2-3 years, starting with the schools
 demonstrating the highest need based on data, and to employ a district PBIS External Coordinator to ensure behavior support
 systems are implemented with fidelity across the district.
- Reviewed proposed revisions to the following policies and administrative regulations:
 - * Policy 705.1 School Attendance Areas
 - * Administrative Regulation 705.1 In-District Student Transfers
- Approved the Freeport School District and CareerTec Bills, the Personnel Report with an addendum, and the Resolution Giving Notice of Withdrawal from Workers' Compensation Self-Insurance Trust.
