2021-2022 Supply List for Parents**

The District will be purchasing supplies for student use for the 21-22 school year. We are asking parents to buy minimal supplies. **Students in grades 9-12 will need basic school supplies such as:**

- Earbuds with a microphone (Foreign Language courses only)
- Notebook paper
- Folders and/or binders
- Pens and/or pencils
- Face mask
- Backpack (FHS only, Students at FAHS will be provided backpacks)

**NOTE:** Teachers will advise students of specific supplies needed for their course during the first week of class.

**Additional Important Information:**

*In an effort to ensure the health and safety of all FSD 145 students, and ensure immediate compliance with state law and Illinois School Code, FSD 145 has established “**First Day Exclusion.**” Under Board policy 7:100, students will **not be admitted** on the first day of school, **August 24, 2021**, if they do not have the required Illinois physical and current immunizations on file. Parents must be sure their child’s physical is complete and includes details of the child’s health history.*

*Therefore, before reporting to school, all FSD 145 students in grades **K, 6, and 9**, or students entering school for the first time (regardless of grade) must have **proof of a complete health examination and up-to-date immunizations** on file.*
