PROM

-Tickets for Prom will go on sale Tuesday, April 23 for \$35/couple or \$20/single.

Tickets may be purchased at the FHS Business Office before school, during passing time, during lunch with a pass and after school ONLY! Only Juniors and Seniors may purchase a ticket and must have their school ID and the completed Prom Ticket Information Sheet. All fines must be checked and PAID BEFORE purchasing a ticket. Student must be passing all classes. No tickets will be sold after 1:00pm on May 3 (the day before Prom) or at the door the night of Prom! Students MUST purchase their ticket by 1:00 pm on Friday, May 3 to attend Prom!

-Not going to Prom but interested in attending Post Prom? Juniors and Seniors may fill out the Prom Ticket Information Sheet and purchase a ticket to attend ONLY Post Prom for \$10 at the Business Office before school, during passing time, during lunch with a pass and after school. ONLY Juniors and Seniors must have their school ID to purchase a ticket. Post Prom will be held at Freeport Middle School. Students can enter through the back pool doors. Several fun things are being planned, including a casino night, caricature artists, hypnotist, photo booth, 3v3 basketball, and much more! ALL FINES MUST

BE PAID prior to purchasing a ticket! No tickets will be sold after 1:00 pm on May 3 or at the door the night of Post Prom on May 4.

-There will be random metal detecting and breathalyzers at the door.

IMPORTANT DATES TO MARK ON YOUR CALENDAR

May 4--PROM

- Tickets go on sale Tuesday, April 23 and will be sold until 1:00 p.m. Friday, May 3. No tickets will be sold at the door. The cost of prom tickets will be \$35/couple or \$20/single. Only Juniors or Seniors will be able to purchase a ticket before school, after school, or during lunch with a pass. Students can also stop during passing time.
- Students must be passing all classes to purchase a prom ticket.
- All fines must be paid before tickets may be purchased.

PROM ATTIRE EXPECTATIONS

- Dresses must cover cleavage and the lower back, as well as reach mid-thigh length (including slit). Dresses must cover belly. No two piece outfits unless the two pieces fully meet together.
- If you have already purchased a dress that violates these guidelines, you must make alterations or wear some sort of cover-up such as a shawl or a jacket.
- Males may only wear hats/headgear that are part of their attire (top hats, etc.) and do not represent gangs or other affiliations.
- Designs cut into the hair must also be appropriate and not reflect a gang or other affiliation.
- Students who attempt to attend Prom in violation of these guidelines for appropriate dress will be expected to leave the dance.

May 6

- Summer School Registration Starts. Summer School will begin June 10th and end on July 11th.

May 7

- Seniors fines are due to the Business Office by the end of the school day.

May 9

- 10:45 Early release day. Periods 1-4.

May 13

- Graduation tickets will be available for pick up Monday May 13 through Thursday May 16 until 3:00pm at the Business Office. A final amount of fines (e.g. unreturned books, unpaid ID fines, sports equipment, lunch fines, Chromebook fines, etc.) will be printed on the envelope of tickets. Seniors must bring a clearance sheet from the library stating that all books and materials have been returned. Seniors must bring clearance sheet from the Tech room stating that all teachers were okay with them turning in their Chromebook and that the Tech Room has signed off on what condition the Chromebook was in when returned and if there are any fines to be issued. **No tickets will be given until all fines have been paid.** Students may pick up their tickets before school, during passing time, during lunch with a pass and after school. Those interested in extra tickets may sign up for them at the Business Office when picking up their tickets. If extra tickets are available, they will be handed out at the end of graduation practice. Any not picked up at that time will receive a phone call after practice on Friday May 17 and will have until 3:00pm to pick them up at the Business Office.

- All seniors will be given six (6) tickets. If you are interested in extra tickets, please sign up for them when you pick up your tickets. If tickets become available, seniors will receive the additional ticket(s) during graduation practice on May 17.

May 15

- The last day of school for seniors. This is a full day of school for all students. Seniors will clean out their lockers during 7th period. There will be trash barrels in the hallway to assist in this process.
- Seniors must be passing all classes needed to graduate by this date in order for your name to be included in the Graduation program.

May 16

- Senior Class Picnic - Krape Park 10:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.
- Convocation – 7:00 p.m. @ the JL Theatre. Seniors should arrive by 6:40 p.m. dressed in the graduation gown but not the cap and tassel. This is the awards ceremony. Students receiving an award will be sent an invitation.

May 17

- Graduation practice will be held at 9:00 a.m. in the west gym. **Practice is mandatory.** Students should arrange their work schedules in advance. Enter at the Empire Street entrance.

May 19

- Graduation in the FHS West Gym beginning at 2:00 p.m. Seniors should arrive by 1:00 p.m. and meet in the cafeteria or east gym as assigned.
- **Purses, camera bags, backpacks, balloons, flowers or noisemakers are not permitted in the gym due to limited space.**
- **Doors will be locked at 2 p.m., and no one will be allowed in after Graduation Ceremony begins.**
- Handicapped seating will be available upon request. Call 232-0417 by May 15 to let the school know of special needs in advance.
- All fines must be paid for students to receive their diploma on graduation day.

GRADUATION DRESS REQUIREMENTS

- Dress shoes and appropriate socks must be worn. Tennis shoes or flip-flops will **not** be allowed.
- Men must wear dress pants. Blue jeans and/or shorts are **not** considered appropriate attire.
- Men need to wear a dress shirt and tie.
- Ladies need to try their dresses on with their gowns. Dresses should not be longer than the bottom of their gown. If pants are worn, they must be dress pants, no blue jeans and/or shorts. Please wear walkable shoes.
- Graduation hats must be flat on the head. Ladies need to try a hairstyle that will allow the hats to sit on the top of their head, not on the back. Bring bobby pins to secure the hats in place.
- Graduates will **not** be allowed to participate if there is additional ornamentation on caps and gowns.
- Any student who does not follow the dress requirements will not take part in the ceremony.

May 31

There is no transportation until 2:35 p.m. Students can obtain a sack lunch in the cafeteria and then leave campus after exams or wait to take the bus home at the normal time.

June 3

- Period 4 Exam 7:30-9:00 a.m. / Period 5 Exam 9:10-10:40 a.m. Students are dismissed at 10:40 a.m. There is no transportation until 2:35 p.m. Students can obtain a sack lunch in the cafeteria

and then leave campus after exams or wait to take the bus home at the normal time.

June 4

- Period 6 Exam 7:30-9:00 a.m. / Period 7 Exam 9:10-10:40 a.m. Students are dismissed at 10:40 a.m. There is no transportation until 2:35 p.m. Students can obtain a sack lunch in the cafeteria and then leave campus after exams or wait to take the bus home at the normal time. There will be trash barrels in the hallway for locker cleanout.
- **Reminder of First Day Exclusion: Students cannot start school in August 2019 unless they have all required physicals and immunizations on file!**
