Dear Parents & Guardians,

The remote learning lessons provided are activities and skills to work on throughout the week. Please choose <u>2 activities to complete with your student each day</u>. The activities can come from any subject. (By the end of the week, your student should have 14 of the 15 provided activities completed.)
