

Examples of qualifying expenses that may be turned in to NIHP for reimbursement:

- Bandages
- Birth control pills and other contraceptive devices
- Blood tests and transfusions
- Chiropractor fees
- Cold medications
- Contact lenses, contact lens solutions and enzyme cleaners
- Dental fees such as x-rays, cleanings, exams, crowns
- Dentures
- Diagnostic fees
- Diabetic supplies and insulin treatments
- Eyeglasses & eye surgeries
- Flu medications
- Hearing aids and batteries
- Hospital services
- Lab tests and fees
- Mammograms
- Menstrual care products
- Oral surgery
- Over-the-counter (OTC) drugs
- Oxygen and oxygen equipment
- Pain relievers
- Physician services
- Prescription medicines
- Saline solution for contact lenses
- Surgeon and surgery fees
- Vaccines
- X-ray

Examples of Non-Qualifying Medical Expenses:

- Advance payment for services rendered in the next year.
- Athletic club memberships
- Cosmetic surgery
- Diaper service
- Funeral, cremation or burial expenses
- Marriage counseling
- Maternity clothes
- Medicare supplement premiums
- Swimming pool
- Vitamins and dietary supplements for general health
